24 OSLO HAVN 1798 Experience Bjørvika in 1798. A 3D film is showing continuously. *Tidvis AS, Skur 38, Vippetangen.*

25 ENVIRONMENT Get to know Oslo as a port city and create street art. *Ung Norge, Vippetangen.*

26 CREATE A LOBSTER HOUSE Learn about marine litter and the species in the Oslo Fjord. Together with Marineoperatørene, you can build and decorate your own lobster house, which we place in the fjord.
